

Entrance Requirements

Applicants need to:

- Submit an application form and personal statement along with academic transcripts.
- Submit three reference letters, including two from a supervisor or administrator familiar with your work.
- Hold a university degree, preference given to those in psychology, social sciences, humanities or health sciences.
- Have work and/or volunteer experience in the care and treatment of children, adolescents, and youth.
- Partake in a minimum of two admission interviews.
- Legally reside in Canada; no International students are accepted.
- Pay an application fee of \$300 via e-transfer to payments@cicapp.com
- Submit applications by June 30.

Accepted Candidates need to:

- Provide satisfactory evidence of their ability to develop insight into their own psychological function.
- Be in a weekly psychoanalytic psychotherapy session with an approved psychoanalytic therapist upon starting the training, and remain in therapy for the majority of their training.
- Have a membership with the <u>Canadian Association of Psychoanalytic</u> <u>Child Therapists</u> (CAPCT). This will be arranged after acceptance and with assistance from CICAPP.
- Submit to a Vulnerable Sector Search completed within the last year in the city of your residence.
